Director's Report

Feels like we are ahead on registrations, we have over 70 in. Prepping the bands for Commencement. Great 8th grade family meeting-thanks to the Boosters, the 1 hour time was perfect. Working on selecting music for marching band, Paul Simon show is confirmed. Working on a dance/Cheer show. Leadership applications for next year will go out in 2-3 weeks, meetings will be the last week of school. Need for another set of tenor drums for next season, can help get a quote. Eliza Kroger (Tremont) is seeking an old band uniform to borrow or purchase, Mr. Fessler will connect her to Uniform Committee. Working on solidifying clinicians for Band Camp (need flute and trumpet). Possible Volleyball pep band on April 29, if it is on, will send signups.

President Report

- No update this month

Vice President Report

- Band camp committee update, went well, will run very much like last year. Will need to replace Bibibop, Banquet will be at Bob Crane Center. Volunteer roster is growing, next meeting is in May.
- By Law revisions-most revisions were spelling/grammar. Added trade/tech school language, BCI check process, Boosters will pay if needed. Other major change was regarding ISTA move to Band Student Fundraising. Added Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics language. Kristin Lach provided feedback that it is unfortunate that all students will benefit from the work of few.

Treasurer's Report

- No big changes to our accounts this month.
- We are working on the budget-will be ready for vote in May meeting

- We have a strong referral for new CPA. Next step is to meet and review our needs.

Development Report

- Sponsorships next year will be on Simple Raise (no fees), will 'cap' at \$1500-the larger amounts are not getting much traction. We will accept sponsorships in higher amounts. Goal is for every band student to earn \$100 in sponsorship funds.
- Flower Sales close April 28, delivery day is May 16 after school. Currently we have over 700 items sold, \$3,500 in profit so far.
- Summer uniforms are for sale until mid-June

Committee Chair Report

- End of Year Celebration-entire budget is ~\$2,500. Need to work in letters and gifts. Senior wills are in progress, Mr. Fessler will follow up on any outstanding.
- Senior gift will be memory books that include the Senior wills
- Do the directors want a picture area at the end of year concert? Note: individual class pictures to be taken on picture day at band camp, use in Senior gift at end of year
- Uniforms-if we want raincoats, we can get them in ~3 months. Hat boxes need to be replaced. Natalie Swider has volunteered to be Uniform Chair.
- Students want chenille letters, they will be purchased.
- Committee will check existing supply, but may need to purchase Quartermaster and Officer cords. Expected need to purchase 7-8 sets to be passed out at Bandquet.
